BIBLE

The Bible is the basis of everything we do. Review the study designed to promote conversation and go deeper into biblical principles. Many times this will be a sermon based study. The overall goal is to learn to live out our faith in Jesus in our everyday life together while applying the Biblical principles we learn.



COMMUNITY

Groups show **community** through praying for each other, offering encouragement, listening, and even challenging one another through mutual accountability.



GENEROUS



OWNER

Over time, growing to know each other's needs will help you serve each other and those in the community around you. We ask that each group practices **generosity** in our community through a community project a minimum of once a session (3 times a year) .We also recommend that everyone demonstrates **ownership** through serving in our church.



AUTHENTIC

Each week it will be important to share what's happening in our lives. At first, we'll likely use provided questions to share, however after a short time, it's likely this will become informal and more personal as you get to know each other. **Authenticity** and growing in trust is crucial to spiritual and relationship growth.

1. Make spiritual growth our number one priority. (Colossians 1:9-10)
2. Accept one another. (Romans 15:7)
3. Take care of each other (Galatians 6:2)
4. Treat each other with respect (Ephesians 4:2)
5. Keep our commitments (Psalm 15:1-5)
